DAILY SUMMARY:

Fri, May 29:

5:10pm departure from ORD. Overnight flight directly to Rome.

Sat, May 30:

Benvenuti a Roma! 9:10am arrival in Rome. Hotel check in. Introduction to the Eternal City with a walking tour in the heart of the city. Visit historical churches, piazzas, fountains, etc. Mass at Santa Maria sopra Minerva, the church of St. Catherine of Siena & Fra Angelico.

Sun, May 31:

Board a coach bus to the outer limits of Rome. Stops at the basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls to pray before the tomb of St. Paul, visit to Tre Fontane: the site of his martyrdom, and tour the catacombs where many saints and popes were buried! Afternoon guided tour of the Coliseum and Roman Forum.

Mon, June 1:

Mass at St. Peter's Basilica followed by a Scavi tour under the basilica to pray before the bones of St. Peter. See the tombs of the popes in the crypt or climb to the top of the dome for endless views

of the city. Optional afternoon guided tour of Vatican Museums & Sistine Chapel.

Tues, June 2:

Mass at Santa Croce where relics from the passion of Christ are reserved. Prayerfully ascend the Holy Steps taken from the palace of Pontius Pilate. Visit to the basilicas of St. John Lateran, the former papal residence, and St. Mary Major, resting place of Pope Francis with relics from the manger of Christ. Afternoon shopping stop for religious items to be blessed by Pope Leo!

Wed, June 3:

Morning Papal Audience followed by Mass at a nearby church. After lunch, depart by bus to Florence, the birthplace of the Renaissance. Take in the beauty of this artistic city - - home of da Vinci, Michelangelo, Raphael & many more!!

Thurs, June 4:

Walking tour of significant churches in Florence - the famed Duomo, Santa Croce where many nobles are buried, Pozzi Chapel & more. Tour the Convento di San Marco - filled with famous Fra Angelico frescoes which inspired St. Mark's parish paintings! Optional afternoon visit to the Uffizi art gallery of prominent sculptures & paintings.

Fri, June 5:

After morning Mass, peruse the outdoor market for local leather and souvenirs. Board the coach bus for Venice! Embark the waterways with your first boat ride to your lodging.

Sat, June 6:

Walking tour of the famous churches of Venice: the Basilica of San Marco, covered in detailed biblical mosaics and resting place of the Gospel writer, the Franciscan Friary & the Gesuiti to name a few. Afternoon boat trip to Murano island for tour of the world-famous glass in the making.

Sun, June 7:

Free day to explore Venice on your own - visit the Doges' Palace, the seat of the Government for the Republic of Venice for centuries, take a gondola ride or savor the beauty of this iconic city with a lunch along a canal. Close out this special time with a celebratory group banquet.

Mon, June 8:

Transfer to Venice airport for return flight home. Connection through Philadelphia.
